

Call for Organized Session Proposals for EcoDesign 2017

Proposals are invited for organized sessions at EcoDesign2017. An organized session is an excellent opportunity to present a group of similarly-focused presentations or to hold a workshop on a wide variety of topics. Organized sessions can be on any relevant topic that would be of interest to EcoDesign2017 participants.

Organized sessions may take the forms of symposium, workshop, or another form as appropriate:

- Symposium: A set of presentations (4 presentations per slot) centered on a specific topic;
- Workshop: on a specific theme or issue, with time for responses and discussion planned in;
- Sessions of any other kind with a clear rationale.

Each of organized sessions will be scheduled for an 80-minute slot or connected two or more slots.

Prospective organizers of organized sessions should post their proposal by email to the EcoDesign2017 secretariat by March 31, 2017. A proposal of organized session should indicate:

1. Session title,
2. Session description,
3. Session organizer(s) (name, affiliation, contact information),
4. Session chair,
5. List of presenters (for sessions with 'symposium' style) (4 presenters per slot),
6. Other information (special requirement).

Organized sessions can also be supplemented with poster presentations presented at the poster session of EcoDesign2017.

Submitted proposals are reviewed by the EcoDesign2017 program committee. Due to limitation of session slots, please understand that not all proposal may be accepted.

For proposals of organized sessions that are accepted, the organizer is responsible for moderation of the session at EcoDesign2017. For the 'symposium' style organized sessions, procedure, regulations and important dates for abstracts/papers are the same as those of regular sessions, and the papers will be published in the symposium proceedings.

Please be aware that EcoDesign2017 could not provide any financial support to organizers and speakers of organized sessions.
